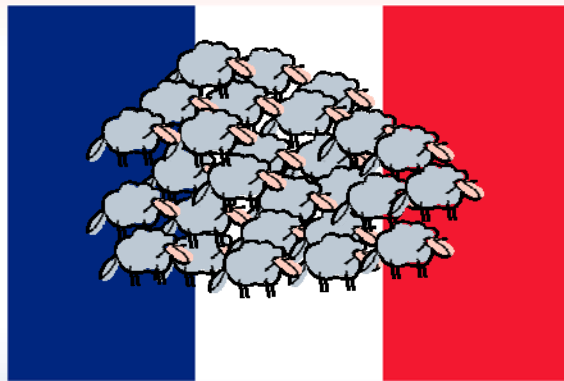

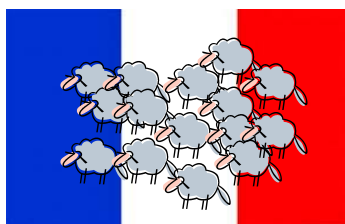

“French” Style RLF Course Level I**GENERAL RULES:**

- Time limit: 20 minutes.
- In all elements, quiet efficient stock work is essential.
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
- In all movement, the flock should remain on the road unless otherwise indicated.
- Ties are broken based on individual scores in the following order: Exercise 4 “Bridge”, Exercise 6 “Re-pen”, Time.

STARTING SET- UP:

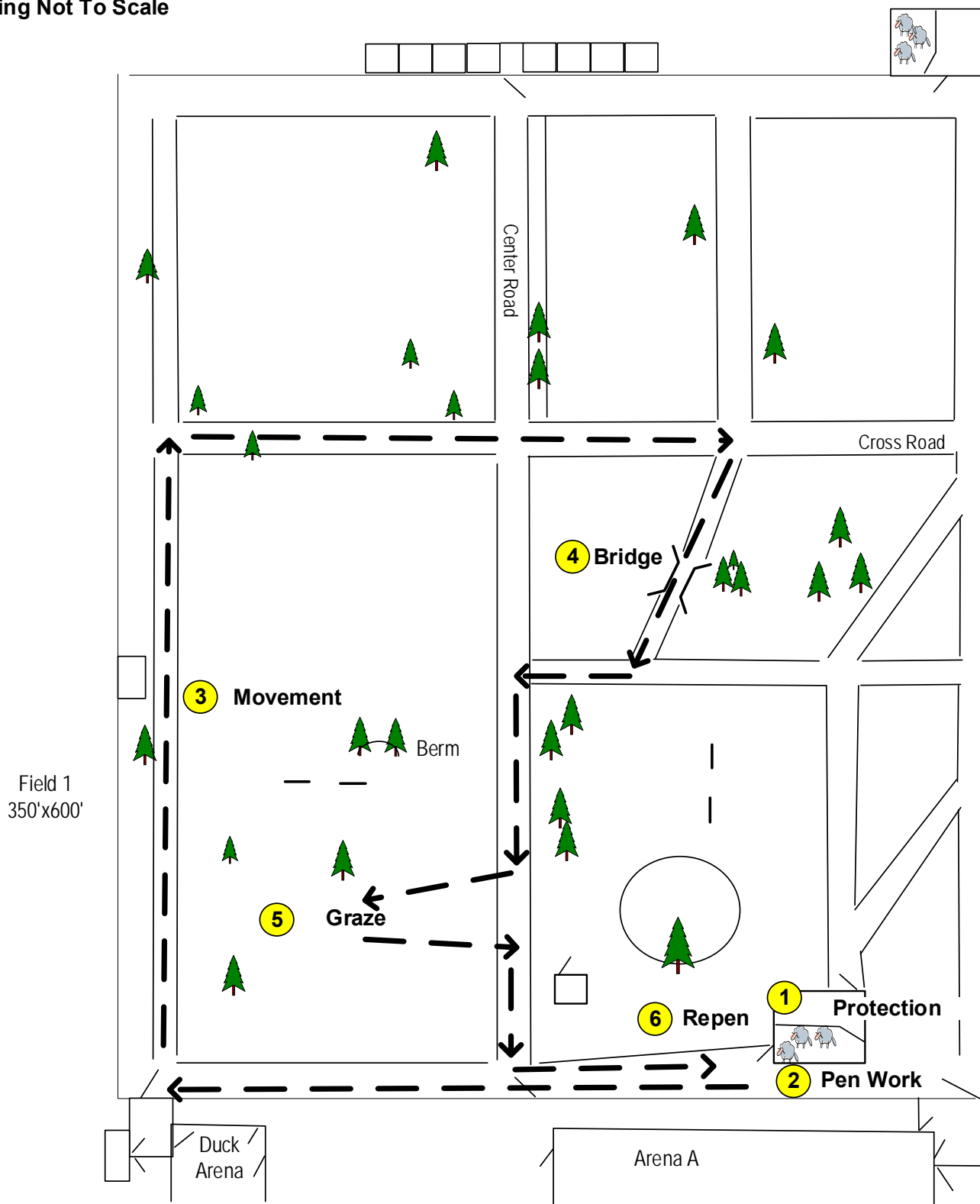
- The gate to the Take Pen is closed.
- The number of sheep used in Level I will be a minimum of 25 sheep.

1. **PROTECTION – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Handler opens the gate to the Take Pen. The handler and dog will enter the pen closing the gate behind them. The dog should clear a path allowing the handler access to the water tank. The handler will add “some” water to the tank while the dog keeps the sheep clear of the handler. The dog will clear a path to the gate and the team shall exit the pen. Exercise ends when the Pen gate is briefly closed.
2. **PEN WORK – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Handler re-opens the gate to the Take Pen. The handler and dog will remove the sheep from the pen. The dog should control the sheep while the handler closes the gate. Exercise ends when the Take Pen gate is closed.
3. **MOVEMENT – 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Take Pen gate is closed. Move sheep along the marked path to the wide road and turn right. Move sheep along the wide road to the cross road, turn the flock right and continue on the cross road. to the Bridge road. Exercise ends when sheep arrive at the Bridge road.
4. **BRIDGE – 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when flock arrives at the Bridge road. Turn onto the Bridge road, move the sheep over the Bridge. The handler may lead the sheep and the dog should cross the bridge. Move the flock onto the Center Road. Exercise ends when all the sheep are on the Center Road.
5. **GRAZE/HOLD/TOUCH - 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when sheep arrive at the Center Road. Move the sheep along the Center Road to the marked graze. The sheep should stay inside the marked graze while the handler and dog remain outside. When signaled by the judge, handler will enter the graze and touch a marked sheep. The dog may enter the graze to hold the sheep while the handler performs the touch. Exercise ends when judge signals that the touch is complete.
6. **REPEN – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when judge signals that the touch is complete. Move sheep to the Re-Pen. The sheep should be held away from the gate while the handler opens it. Re-pen the sheep. Exercise ends and time stops when the gate is closed.

“French” Style RLF Course Level II

GENERAL RULES:

- Time limit: 30 minutes.
- In all elements, quiet efficient stock work is essential.
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
- In all movement, the flock should remain on the road unless otherwise indicated.
- Ties are broken based on individual scores in the following order: Exercise 5 “Bridge”, Exercise 9 “Re-pen”, Time.

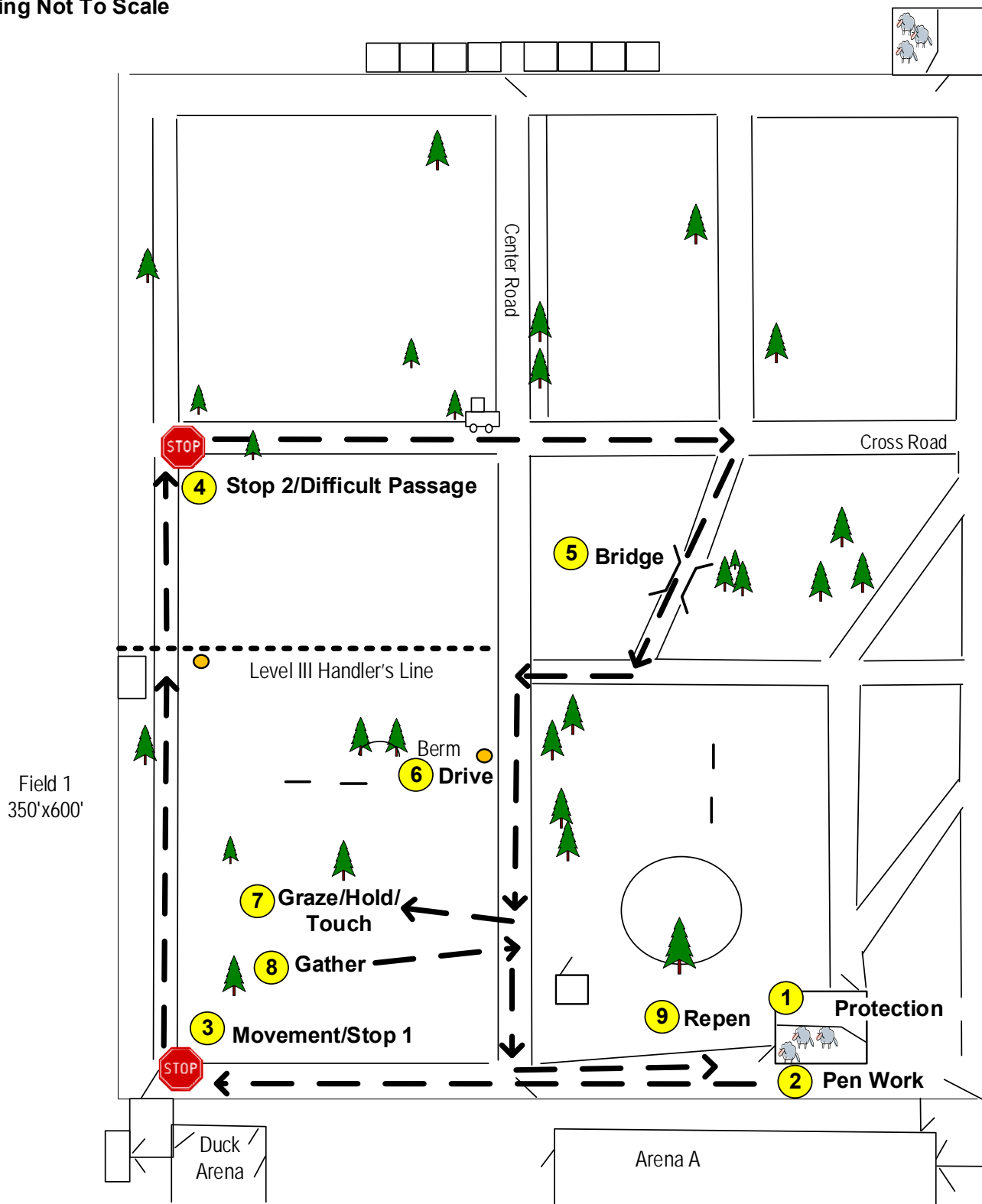
STARTING SET- UP:

- The gate to the Take Pen is closed.
 - The number of sheep used in Level II will be a minimum of 25 sheep.
1. **PROTECTION – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Handler opens the gate to the Take Pen. The handler and dog will enter the pen closing the gate behind them. The dog should clear a path allowing the handler access to the water tank. The handler will add “some” water to the tank while the dog keeps the sheep clear of the handler. The dog will clear a path to the gate and the team shall exit the pen. Exercise ends when the Pen gate is briefly closed.
 2. **PEN WORK – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Handler re-opens the Take Pen gate. The handler and dog will remove the sheep from the pen. The dog should control the sheep while the handler closes the gate. Exercise ends when the Take Pen gate is closed.
 3. **MOVEMENT/STOP 1 – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Take Pen gate is closed. Move sheep along the marked path to the wide road. Prior to reaching the wide road, the handler will fall back to the rear of the flock sending the dog to stop the flock just prior to the road. While the dog holds the sheep, the handler moves past the flock to check for traffic and then sends the dog back around to bring the sheep onto wide road. Move along the wide road to the cone near the Level III Handler’s Line. Exercise ends when sheep reach the Handler’s Line.
 4. **STOP 2/DIFFICULT PASSAGE – 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when sheep reach the Level III Handler’s Line. Move sheep along the wide road to the cross road. Upon reaching the cross road, stop the flock and check for traffic before turning right onto the cross road. Move along the Cross Road past the parked car. As the flock approaches the parked car, move sheep to the side of the road with the dog between the flock and the vehicle. After you have passed the vehicle, continue along the cross road to the Bridge road. Exercise ends when sheep arrive at the Bridge road.
 5. **BRIDGE – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when flock arrives at the Bridge road. Turn onto the Bridge road, move the sheep over the Bridge. The handler may lead the sheep and the dog should cross the bridge. Move the flock onto the Center Road. Exercise ends when all the sheep are on the Center Road.
 6. **DRIVE – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when sheep arrive at the Center Road. Move the sheep along the Center Road to the cone. Upon reaching the cone, the handler must move behind the flock in a “walking drive” position until the marked graze is reached. Exercise ends when the sheep enter the marked graze.
 7. **GRAZE/HOLD/TOUCH - 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when the sheep enter the marked graze. The sheep should stay inside the marked graze while the handler and dog remain outside. When signaled by the judge, handler will enter the graze and touch a marked sheep. The dog may enter the graze to hold the sheep while the handler performs the touch. Exercise ends when judge signals that the touch is complete.
 8. **GATHER – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when judge signals that the touch is complete. The Handler will return to the Drive Marker while the dog remains with the sheep. When handler reaches the Drive Marker the handler will recall dog. The dog is then sent from the Marker to gather the sheep to the handler. Exercise ends when sheep arrive at Drive Marker.
 9. **REPEN – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the sheep arrive at the Drive Marker. Move sheep to the Re-Pen. The sheep should be held away from the gate while the handler opens it. Re-pen the sheep. Exercise ends and time stops when the gate is closed.

GENERAL RULES:

- Time limit: 45 minutes.
- In all elements, quiet efficient stock work is essential.
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
- In all movement, the flock should remain on the road unless otherwise indicated.
- Ties are broken based on individual scores in the following order: Exercise 5 “Bridge”, Exercise 9 “Re-pen”, Time.

STARTING SET- UP:

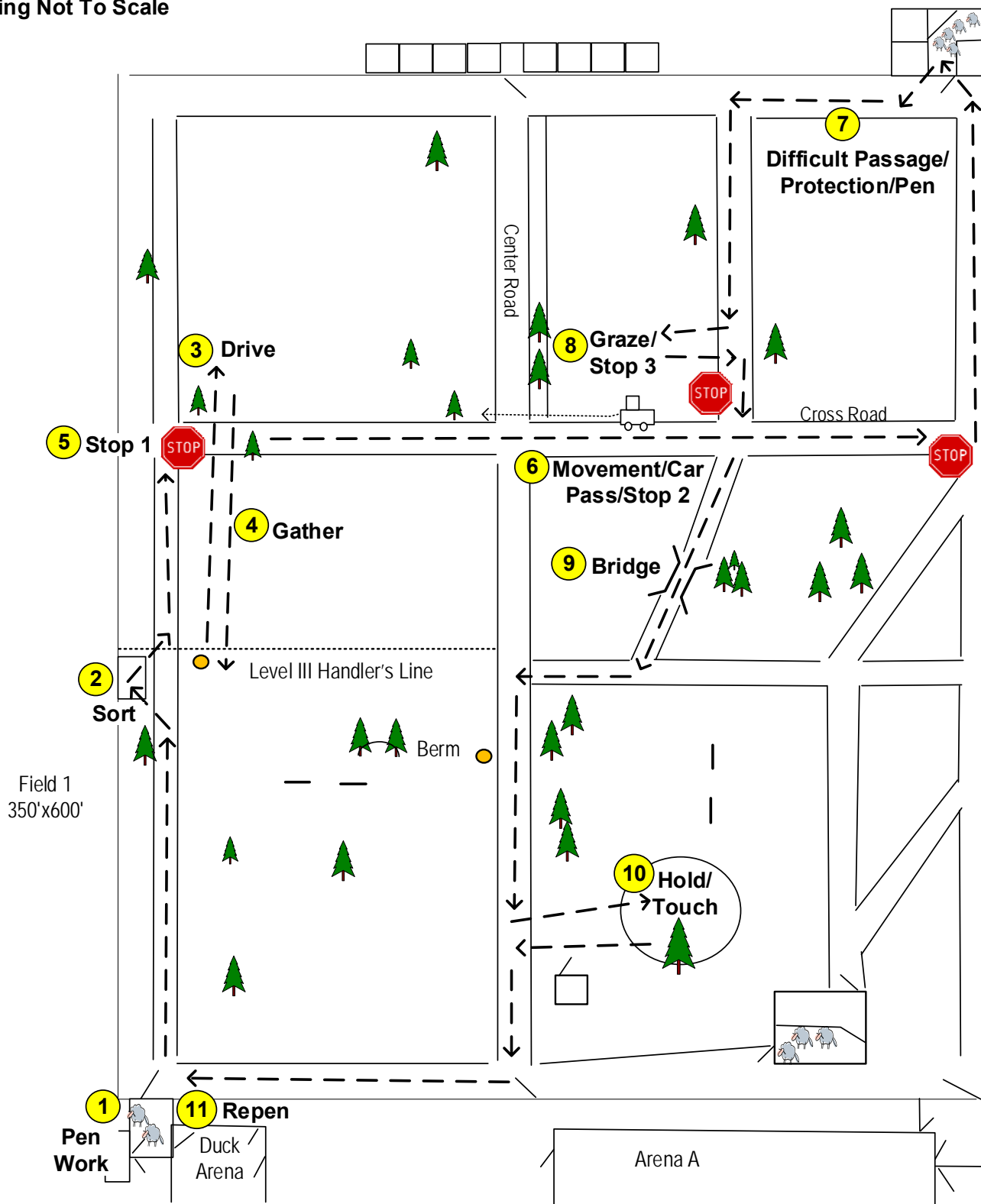
- The gate to the Take Pen is closed.
 - The number of sheep used in Level II will be a minimum of 40 sheep.
1. **PEN WORK – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Handler opens the Take Pen gate. The handler sends the dog to remove the sheep from the pen. The dog should control the sheep while the handler closes the gate. Exercise ends when the Take Pen gate is closed.
 2. **SORT – 20 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Take Pen gate is closed. Move along the Wide Road to the Sort Pen. Sort sheep into pen leaving 10 sheep of your choice outside the pen. Exercise ends when the Sort Pen is closed.
 3. **DRIVE – 15 pts.:** Exercise ends when the Sort Pen is closed. Move the 10 sheep to the Center Road. Upon reaching the Handler’s Line, the handler must remain behind the line while the dog drives the sheep between the 2 marked trees. Exercise ends when the sheep move past the trees.
 4. **GATHER – 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when the sheep move past the trees. The Handler will recall dog, the dog is then sent from the Handler’s Line to gather the sheep to the handler. Remove the remaining sheep from the Sort Pen, this can be done any time after the dog is sent to gather the sheep. Exercise ends when sheep arrive at the Handler’s Line and are combined with the sheep from the Sort Pen.
 5. **STOP 1 – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when all sheep are combined into one group. Move sheep along the Wide Road to the Cross Road. Prior to reaching the wide road, the handler will fall back to the rear of the flock sending the dog to stop the flock just prior to the road. While the dog holds the sheep, the handler moves past the flock to check for traffic and then sends the dog back around to bring the sheep onto Cross Road. Exercise ends when sheep turn right onto the Cross Road.
 6. **MOVEMENT/CAR PASS/STOP 2 – 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when sheep turn right onto the Cross Road. Move sheep along the Cross Road. As the vehicle approaches, move sheep to the side of the road with the dog between the flock and the vehicle. After you have passed the vehicle, continue along the cross road to the Perimeter Road. Upon reaching the Perimeter Road, stop the flock and check for traffic before turning left onto the Perimeter Road. Exercise ends when sheep turn onto the Perimeter Road.
 7. **DIFFICULT PASSAGE/PROTECTION/PEN – 20 pts.:** Exercise ends when sheep turn onto the Perimeter Road. Move sheep along Perimeter Road to the Holding Pen. Utilizing the 6’ gate, pen the sheep in the alley/open pen. Team will enter the pen closing the gate. The dog should clear a path allowing the handler to circle the pen observing the flock. Return to the gate and have the dog remove ALL the sheep from the pens. The dog should control the sheep while the handler closes the gate. Exercise ends when the Holding Pen gate is closed.
 8. **GRAZE/STOP 3 - 15 pts.:** Exercise begins when the Holding Pen gate is closed. Move the sheep down the narrow roads to the marked Graze. The sheep should stay inside the marked graze while the handler and dog remain outside. When the judge signals that the graze is complete, the team will move the sheep onto the narrow road toward the Cross Road. Upon reaching the Cross Road, stop the flock and check for traffic before crossing the Cross Road onto the Bridge Road. Exercise ends when sheep reach the Bridge Road.
 9. **BRIDGE – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when sheep reach the Bridge road. Continue along the Bridge road, moving the sheep over the Bridge. The handler may lead the sheep and the dog should cross the bridge. Move the flock onto the Center Road. Exercise ends when sheep are on the Center Road.
 10. **HOLD/TOUCH – 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when sheep are on the Center Road. Move the sheep into the hold area where your dog will independently hold the sheep in the open while you touch a marked sheep. Exercise ends when the judge signals that the touch is complete.
 11. **REPEN – 10 pts.:** Exercise ends when the judge signals that the touch is complete. Move the sheep to the Re-Pen. The sheep should be held away from the gate while the handler opens it. Re-pen the sheep. Exercise ends and time stops when the gate is closed.
