Frog's Breath Herding Ranch Dog Trial Sheep (HRDs) October 25, 26, 27, 2019

GENERAL RULES:

- Time: 20 minutes.
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
- Ties are broken based on individual scores in the following order: Exercise #1"Gather," Exercise #5 "Free Standing Pen," Time.

STARTING SET-UP:

- There will be a set of (5) five sheep in five all the small holding pens, in the barn and in Field 1a.
- All gates will be closed, including guillotine gates in chute and must be closed at the completion of the run
- SMALL PENS- 10 pts.: Time and the exercise begin when the gate to the designated small pen is opened. The sheep
 will be taken from the small Pen through to Pen A. If the sheep come out of the small pen before the handler or dog
 enter no points will be deducted for this. This exercise ends when the gate between Pens A & B is closed.
- 2. CHUTE & SORT 25 pts.: This exercise begins when the gate between Pens A & B is closed. Load the sheep into the chute, through to the barn. Gate sort the one sheep with the ribbon into the Pen adjoining the chute. Return the sorted sheep back into Pen A and into the chute to join the sheep in the barn. The exercise ends when the guillotine gates are closed.
- 3. GATHER 15 pts.: The exercise begins when the guillotine gate closed. In Field 1-a put feed into the pan, move sheep to it. Call dog off move to the location in the field appropriated to the dog's level. Send the dog, gather the sheep and move them to the second cone.
- HRDI The dog will be at the Cone 1. The Handler may walk to within 15 feet of the sheep.
- HRDII The dog will be at the Cone 2, the Handler may move up to the Cone 1.
- HRDIII The dog and Handler will be at the Cone 2. The Handler will remain at Cone 2 until the sheep have passed the Cone.
- 4. **DRIVE OBSTACLE 1 20 pts.:** This exercise begins when the sheep pass the Handler's Cone 2. Move the sheep through Obstacle either way but whichever way is first selected it the way the sheep must pass through the obstacle. Turn down the arena moving the sheep to the front of the free-standing Pen gate. Exercise ends when the sheep arrive in front of the Free-Standing Pen's gate. between Field 1 & 1a is closed.
- HRDI The Handler may move with the dog and sheep throughout the exercise.
- HRDII The Handler will remain at the Cone 2 until the sheep pass Cone 1.
- **HRDIII** The Handler will remain at the Cone 2 thought-out this exercise.
- 5. **OBSTACLE 2 (HRDIII ONLY) 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the sheep reach Obstacle 2 area. Move sheep through the Obstacle. Exercise ends when the last sheep has exited the obstacle.
- 6.. PENS 20 pts.: This exercise begins when the sheep reach the Obstacle 2 area, levels HRD I & II or HRDIII when the last sheep exits the obstacle. Move sheep though Pens C & B into the empty Pen. Move the sheep in the barn into the chute. Put a ribbon on one sheep, move them into Field 1a. Exercise and time end when the gate into Field 1a is closed.
